

## **SUNDANCE KIDS BREEDING/SHOW DOES**

You have a Market Goat project. Do you have room to have a doe and possible get her bred and have babies for your meat goat project next year? What else would you do with a Breeding doe?

Breeding does can show at the fair and will show separately from Market Goats typically. Breeding does typically are not weighed, but are put into age classes. So a doe that is say 6-9 mos of age will show against other does that are 6-9 mos.

There are also other shows that you can show your stock, to help you learn more about breeding does, how to clip and fit, and how to show and give you more confidence in the show ring, win prizes and meet lots of people.

The American Boer Goat Association also has a Jr. Program where you can become a member. This organization is nationwide, and offers many incentives for joining, including Scholarship opportunities. There will also be a Western Regional Show at the Calaveras County Fairgrounds in Angles Camp on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012, open to all juniors showing. There will be premium money paid out and Belt Buckles for the Champions.

We will offer 10 Show/Breeding does for the youth at our Field Day this year, on February 4<sup>th</sup> 2012. The prices on these will range from \$250.00 to \$400.00 and these will be born in September 2011. These does will all meet breed standards, will have good teat structure and will be of show quality. These are special prices for those involved in 4-H & FFA or the Jr. Show circuit. We will provide registration papers on them, so that you can show them at any of the ABGA shows in the area, or at your fair if they offer breeding classes. Your breeding doe while raising her to show will be on the same grain as your market wether and will also require the same minerals. When your show season is over for your doe, she can be on pasture and fed supplemental hay. They only need to be up on feed during the show season.

April 21<sup>st</sup> – Stockton, CA - Valley Classic  
June 30<sup>th</sup> – Angles Camp, CA – 49'er Jubilee  
July – Sacramento - California State Fair  
August 25<sup>th</sup> – Summer Sizzler  
October – San Francisco – Cow Palace

If you have any questions or are looking for an older doe that can be bred now to kid out in the spring, let me know so that we can meet your needs. We will also have goats in a sale on April 28<sup>th</sup> at the Stockton Fairgrounds. These will be auction prices.
